**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY WATER AGENCY CODE
AMENDING APPENDIX 2, SCHEDULE D OF TITLE 2 RELATING TO
ZONE 11 CREDIT SCHEDULE**

The Board of Directors of the Sacramento County Water Agency ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Appendix 2, Schedule D of Title 2 of the Sacramento County Water Agency Code is amended to read as shown in Attachment A to this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. This ordinance was introduced and the title thereof read at the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Sacramento County Water Agency on _____, and on _____, further reading was waived by the unanimous vote of the Directors present.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after thirty (30) days from the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the same, said publication to be made in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sacramento.
