

INITIAL PUBLIC NOTICE

Sacramento County— Phase 3 Elevations HMGP-4344-062-084

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) intends to provide federal financial assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to Sacramento County to mitigate high flood risk from Morrison creek watershed, Sacramento River, Franklin floodplain, the Cosumnes River, and the Mokolumne River. Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 (Floodplain Management) and FEMA's implementing regulations at Title 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 9, FEMA hereby provides interested parties with a notice of its intent to carry out an action affecting a floodplain.

The purpose of the proposed action is to elevate the residential structures above the base flood elevation using structural beams and new flood resistant foundations to mitigate impacts to the homeowners from flooding. These residences are located in Zone AE, an area of 1-percent probability of flooding every year, on the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Map Numbers 06067C0560H, 06067C0450H, & 06067C0327H, effective August 16th 2012.

Maps of the project areas and their locations within the floodplain and wetland are available for public inspection. All parties interested in receiving a copy of the map should contact FEMA's Region IX office at the address or phone number below.
