

How to Take Your Project Photographs

In order for your rebate application to be approved, the photographs provided must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be in color.



2. Cannot be a close-up shot. Stand back far enough to include your home, street, or fence.





BEFORE: Photo from the curb showing driveway and front yard where the customer plans to remove turf. The street and home are used as reference points.



AFTER: Photo from the same vantage point after the project is completed. Turf has been replaced with Program compliant plants.

BEFORE: Photo is too up-close. It does not include any reference points such as home, street, sidewalk, or fences.



AFTER: This photo is too up-close. You cannot see the converted area or any reference points such as home, street, sidewalk, or fences.

3. Cannot be an online image such as Google street view.



4. Must include at least three (3) photographs to represent the conversion area. JPEG format is preferred.

5. The photographs provided must be a current representation of the condition of the yard.
